AACS is excited to host their second annual Neighborhood Forest!



We love trees! We want to give every child the priceless joy of planting and watching trees grow. By doing so, we will beautify our neighborhoods, put a significant dent in our carbon footprint, and help instill in the hearts of our little ones a sense of magic, wonder, and love for our planet.

Since 2010, Neighborhood Forest has reached over 1,500 schools, libraries, and youth groups – engaged over 500,000 families – and planted over 130,000 (mostly urban and residential) trees through the hands of children and parents across North America.

How does it work?

Schools, libraries, and youth groups enroll in the program. Parents sign-up to get a free tree for their child ahead of Earth Day. Trees for kids are distributed, via the school, library, or youth group to plant with their family during Earth Week (April 22-30).

Counseling Corner

Perseverance

This month Mrs. Smith will be working with students to understand and practice perseverance, along with teaching them about personal space, and the concept of thinking and speaking bubbles.

For perseverance, discuss the importance of not giving up when faced with challenges. We will work on setting achievable goals and tracking progress to help reinforce the concept.

When teaching about personal space, we will read a book and have discussions on the different types of personal space (e.g., personal, social, and public) and when it's appropriate to respect each type. We will then use role-playing scenarios to help students understand how to assert their boundaries respectfully.

Finally in teaching the importance of differentiating when to use our thinking and speaking bubbles, to help find success in our friendships we will introduce the concept of how our thoughts and words can impact our feelings and actions.




