

## All About Trustworthiness

Parents,

Hello! Here at school, we have been very busy learning about trustworthiness- what it means and how we can be a trustworthy friend! Learning happens best when it is done both at school and at home. Below are many ways that you can help your child continue to learn about the theme of trustworthiness through reading about it, talking about it, and practicing it! We have really enjoyed exploring this topic at school, and I hope your family will enjoy it just as much!

#### Practice It!

Use building blocks to build a tower with your child. Each time you add a block to the tower, talk about one thing that can build trust. Every so often, talk about something that would break trust. Then, knock the tower down. Repeat the activity as desired. Talk with your child about how trust can be built and destroyed.

#### Talk About It!

Here are some discussion points to help you talk about trustworthiness with your child:

- What do you think trustworthiness means and why is it important?
  - Do you think you are trustworthy? Why or why not?
  - . Do you think your friends are trustworthy? Why or why not?
- Tell me about a time when you were tempted to lie or do something that wasn't trustworthy. What happened?
  - •Has anyone ever lied to you? How did it make you feel?
    - Are there any secrets that you shouldn't keep?

## **Exciting things happening in Technology!**

At Aurora Academy, we believe that 21st century skills are vitally important for our students to learn. To that end, we have been working on several things this first quarter. Primary Elementary students (Grades K-2) are about to be introduced to circuits, Intermediate Elementary students (Grades 3-5) have begun an interactive coding program, and now Middle School has begun to engage in a STEM engineering platform.

As you can see from the photographs, students are very engaged as they construct their first project, a simple inclined plane. This can be used to calculate Ideal Mechanical Advantage (IMA), the assumption that no energy is lost to friction, wear, or resistance. We see this in our world everywhere, in disability access ramps, furniture dollies, and highway on/off ramps. Students are completing projects to demonstrate how different IMA can be achieved by adjusting ramp height and length using these great kits from Sphero. Keep an eye out for future STEM project updates!



### 8th Grade "Keystone" Field Trip

The 8th grade class went back to Keystone Science School... sort of. Students went camping with Keystone Science School staff for more outdoor, experiential learning, but this time in Golden Gate Canyon State Park. They took part in team building activities, learned about Colorado watersheds, went on a nature hike, and discussed the significance of water management in Colorado and the Southwest United States. They braved the elements, learning how to camp in tents, and had fun forming memories and friendships to last a life time.


